


COVID-19 Workflow for Ambulatory Settings

SYMPTOM CHECK

Upon Entry: Does the patient have symptoms of acute illness? (such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, myalgias, vomiting, sore throat, diarrhea, congestion, headache, etc.)



Proceed as routine visit with patient and caregiver masked

COVID 19 antigen swab collection:

midturbinate swab (approx 1 inch insertion and role 5 times against mucosa on each side) COVID 19 Synergy PCR collection: midturbinate swab AND oropharynx swab

Rooming

- Ensure patient and any caregiver are masked
 - Warm transfer patient to clinical staff
- Clinical staff will immediately place masked patient in private room with door closed
 - Keep distance from patient if possible
 - Immediately after patient is in private room, apply Droplet/Contact sign to door

*PPE REQUIRED Contact/Droplet pro

Contact/Droplet precautions including: gown, gloves, mask, and eye protection



Assessment, Testing and Treatment Plan

Perform clinically relevant assessment & testing (strep, RSV, flu), including BD Veritor COVID-19 antigen Point of Care Test if available

- If COVID-19 antigen positive: No PCR required COVID dx is confirmed and should be reported to ADPH (https://epiweb.adph.state.al.us/redcap/surveys/?s=WK7TY9PT7J)
 - If COVID-19 antigen negative: order and collect Synergy COVID-19 PCR. Specimen should be couriered to hospital lab for Synergy pick up. *Provide supportive care and management as clinically indicated*

**Please note: COVID-19 testing should be performed for all symptomatic patients, even in the presence of other confirmed illness (flu. RSV, etc.)



Patient Disposition

- Home: Provide discharge instructions, including isolation if COV2 antigen (+) or quarantine information if PCR pending. Provide other relevant discharge teaching
- Hospitalization: Follow normal direct admit protocol. If confirmed or suspected
 COVID -19 notify direct admit nurse or patient access



Post-discharge Cleaning

For suspected or confirmed COVID-19: Proceed with room decontamination after the patient is discharged
