

Employee Infection and Exposures Contingency Plan

COVID TESTING REQUIREMENTS	
Symptomatic employees	 Testing required for all employees, regardless of vaccination status (boosted, vaccinated and unvaccinated). If positive, follow Work Restrictions for COVID-Positive Employees. If negative, return to work when fever free for 24 hours.
Asymptomatic, fully-vaccinated employees with high-risk exposure to COVID-positive individual	 No work restrictions No testing requirement Must wear KN95 mask for 14 days from time of exposure at all times in the healthcare facility. Monitor for symptoms and seek testing if symptoms develop.
Asymptomatic, unvaccinated employees with high-risk exposure to COVID-positive individual	 No work restrictions Testing requirement: daily rapid COVID testing for 5 days Must wear KN95 mask for 14 days from time of exposure at all times in the healthcare facility.

WORK RESTRICTIONS FOR COVID-POSITIVE EMPLOYEES

COVID-positive, symptomatic employees,	Work restriction for a minimum of 5 days
regardless of vaccination status (boosted,	• Return to work in 7 days without test, once asymptomatic.
vaccinated and unvaccinated)	May return to work after minimum 5-day work restriction,
	if symptoms have resolved, and Rapid COVID Antigen
	(not PCR) is negative.
	Must be fever free for a minimum of 24 hours without
	the use of Tylenol or Motrin.
	Must wear KN95 upon return to work for 10 days from
	symptoms onset.
