COVID TESTING REQUIREMENTS		
Symptomatic employees	 Testing required for all employees, regardless of vaccination status (boosted, vaccinated and unvaccinated). If positive, follow Work Restrictions for COVID-Positive Employees. If negative, return to work when fever free for 24 hours. 	
Asymptomatic employees, regardless of vaccination status or exposure	 No work restrictions No testing requirement 	

WORK RESTRICTIONS FOR COVID-POSITIVE EMPLOYEES

COVID-positive employees , regardless of vaccination status	 Employees can return to work if they test negative 5 days after the onset of symptoms, are afebrile, (without fever), and symptoms are improving. Employees who remain positive 5 days after the onset of symptoms can return to work on day 7 without additional testing if afebrile and symptoms are improving. If no test is done on day 5 after the onset of symptoms, employees can return to work on day 7 if afebrile and symptoms are improving. All employees who return to work after a COVID-19 diagnosis should wear an N95 mask until day 14
	 All employees who return to work atter a COVID-19 diagnosis should wear an N95 mask until day 14 after the onset of symptoms and refrain from eating in the company of others.
