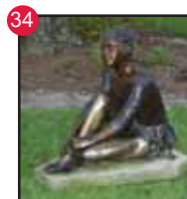

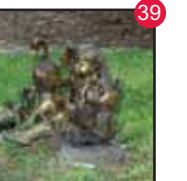

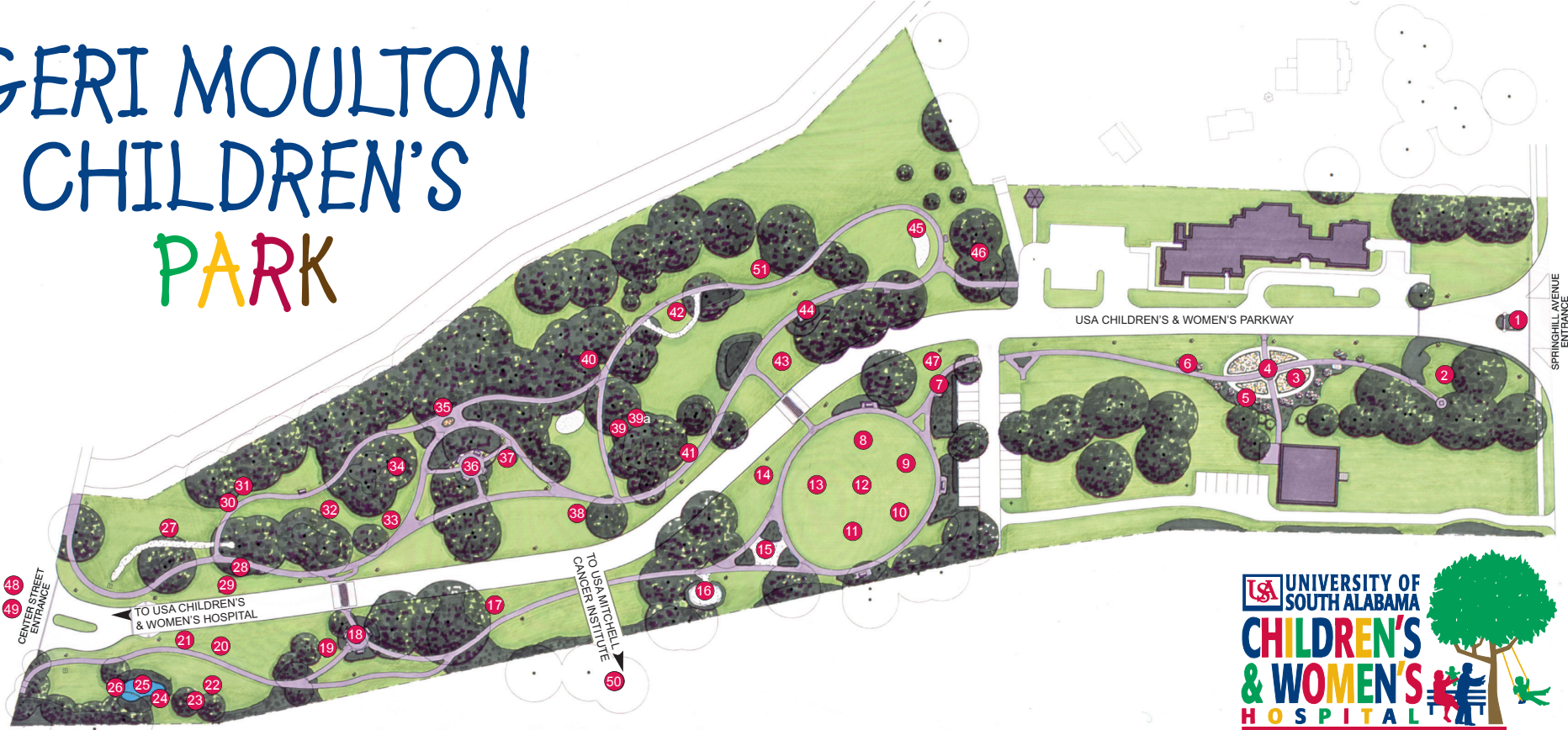

The park is filled with more than 50 life-size bronze sculptures depicting children and families, providing a wonderful place of enjoyment and contemplation, and new sculptures are constantly being added. Patrons, patient families and hospital

## HOW TO FIND US

**Traveling I-65:** Take Springhill Avenue, Exit 5A and turn right onto Springhill Avenue. Drive approximately 2.5 miles and turn left at USA Children's & Women's Parkway. Free parking is on your left.

**Traveling I-10 West:** Take U.S. Highway 98 West, Exit 27. Follow Highway 98 West approximately 3 miles (turning right on Broad and left on Springhill) and turn right at USA Children's & Women's Parkway. Free parking is on your left.

**Traveling I-10 East:** Take Water Street, Exit 26-B. Turn left at Government Street, U.S. Highway 98. Follow Highway 98 West approximately 3 miles (turning right on Broad and left on Springhill) and turn right at USA Children's & Women's Parkway. Free parking is on your left.
