Dear Supporters,


Our fiscal year 2023 has ended with an exciting announcement of Providence joining the University of South Alabama and USA Health System. Obviously there is a lot of work ahead of us in moving towards transitioning our operations later in this calendar year. We are very grateful to our supporters who have continued to stand by Providence and we hope you will continue to stand by Providence as we transition to our local partner in USA Health. I reflect on the fact that every ending is a new beginning. We ask for your support in maintaining a positive outlook as we strive to take the best of Providence and combine it with the best of USA Health.



The last year has been an exciting time and an incredible amount of work for our Foundation. We held our third annual charity Clay Shoot, our 23rd annual Charity Golf Classic and brought back Festival of Flowers to the campus. I want to thank all of our volunteers and staff who made all of these events successful. Through fundraising efforts over the years, the foundation also supported Providence's \$1.4 Million dollar replacement of our Interventional Radiology room making the best equipment in the market available to our patients and physicians. This equipment would not have been possible without the support of our Foundation.

As you may remember last year, we had built a new bariatric surgical services line for our community by recruiting Dr. Daniel Laan. Dr. Laan joined our medical staff in August of 2021. I am pleased to announce that under the leadership of Dr. Laan and Richard Metzger, our VP of Operations, our bariatric surgical services program has become accredited as a Bariatric Comprehensive Center through the American College of Surgeons. This will allow our program to become available to more patients and is a reflection of the highest quality of care being given to our community.

This year, Providence Hospital was also nominated as one of 50 hospitals across the country to be "The Most Beautiful Hospital." After 2 months of voting, Providence was announced the winner of "The Most Beautiful Hospital." This comes after a decade of plant upgrades, remodeling and beautification efforts around campus that have paid great dividends in creating a peaceful and healing environment for our patients and visitors. We still have work to do but we have come a long way. This work would not have been possible without the support of the foundation and on behalf of the leadership and staff of Providence Hospital, we want to thank you as a supporter and we pray that God continues to bless you and keep you as you act as a leader in the Mobile community.

Since 1854, with special attention to the poor and vulnerable, Providence Hospital has offered quality healthcare to our community. Moving forward, this quest remains the same.

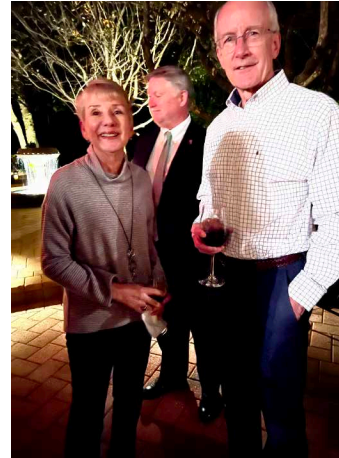
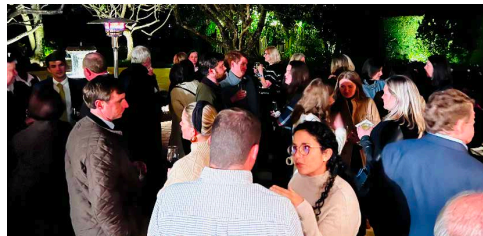

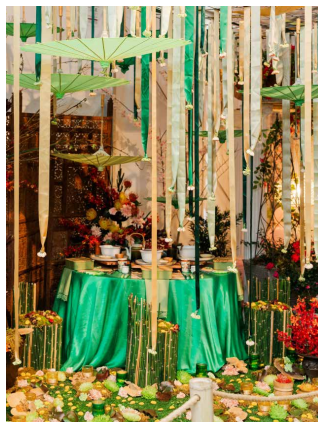
